// BEST OF LÝTINGSSTAÐIR – PROGRAM

MONDAY

Guests are picked up at the bus station in Varmahlíð at 02:30 pm and transferred to Lýtingsstaðir. The arrival is followed by a first meeting, a cup of coffee and a short ride where the guides introduce you to the Icelandic way of riding. Dinner and accommodation at Lýtingsstaðir.

THUESDAY

After breakfast, we start our day with a ride into the beautiful valley Gilhagidalur, which we reach by a steep path. We take our picnic with us in saddle bags and rest at a romantic place beside the little river with its unique rock formations. On the way back we can enjoy the magnificent view over our valley and Skagafjörður as we head down the mountain. Back at the farm coffee and cake will be served and you have some free time until dinner. We spend the evening under the motto Horses & Heritage and get an informative guided tour through the turf house of Lýtingsstaðir, The Old Stable.



WEDNESDAY

After breakfast we saddle up and do a little treasure hunt through our valley under the name The Icelandic Farm Animals. Questions must be answered and there is a small price in the end. We get to know two neighbour farms and finish the ride on Lýtingsstaðir. After a small lunch and some time to relax we saddle up again and ride to a nearby forest. Dinner.

THURSDAY

After breakfast, we will take you on an excursion by bus through Skagafjörður. We visit Hólar with its historical cathedral and university and will see the small turf church Gröf. We will then take a relaxing bath in the vaunted swimming pool at Hofsó. Afterwards, we head back to the farm via Sauðárkrókur. After dinner we go on a ride together and if we are lucky, the Midnight Sun will accompany us.

FRIDAY

After breakfast, we saddle up again for a nice final tour through our valley. We look for a good place for the picnic and enjoy the day and the view. Back at the farm await us coffee and cake. Afterwards, we can visit our herd of foals and take a walk over our property. We end the day with a delicious barbeque and spend the last evening together talking about the past days full of new experiences. Last night in Lýtingsstaðir.
